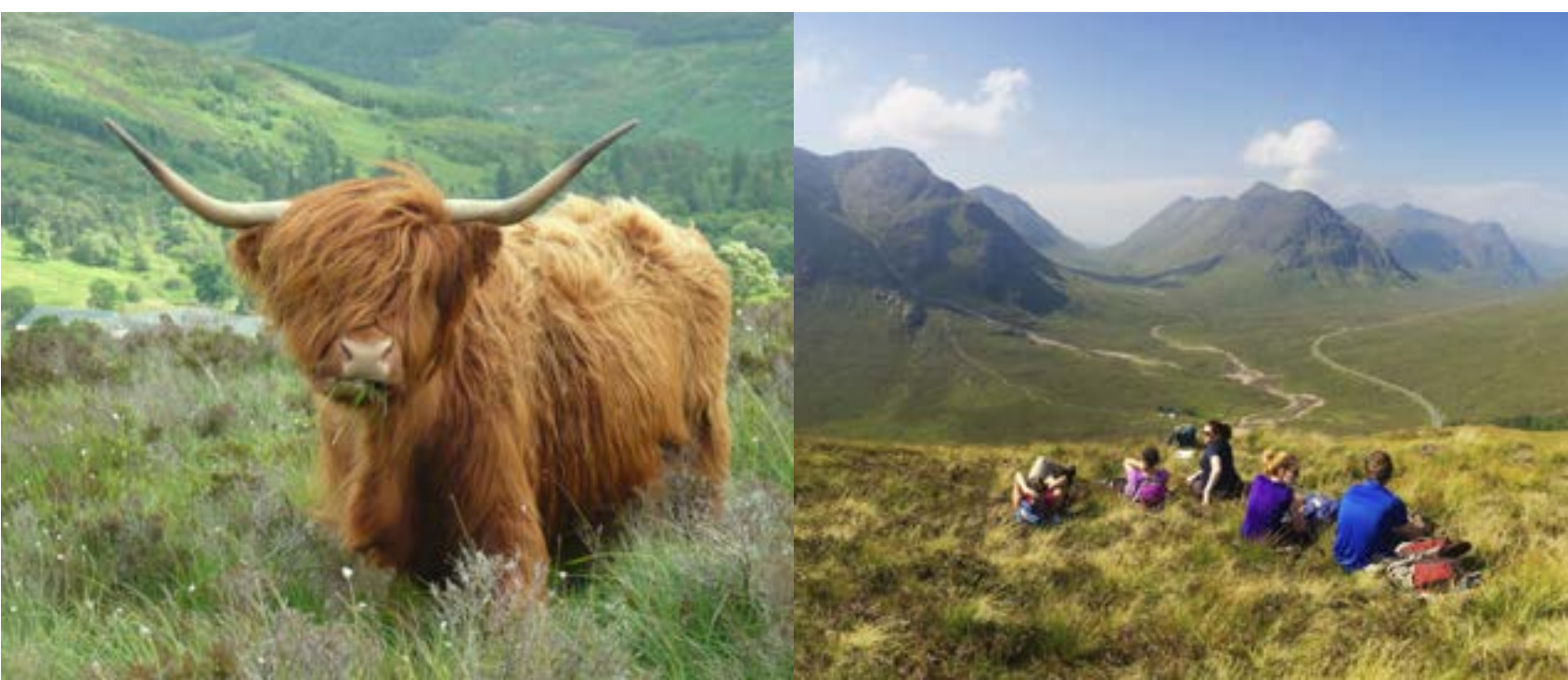

### Ben Nevis

The highest mountain in the British Isles at 1345m. The summit, which is the collapsed dome of an ancient volcano, features the ruins of an observatory which was continuously staffed between 1883 and 1904.

### Steall Waterfall

The spectacular waterfall is situated in Glen Nevis near Fort William. It's Scotland's second highest waterfall with a single drop of 120 metres.

### West Highland Museum

Situated in the High Street of Fort William, The West Highland Museum's collections tell the story of the region and its history. The most renowned and unusual collection relates to Bonnie Prince Charlie and the Jacobite cause.

### Jacobite Steam Train

The Jacobite is a steam locomotive-hauled tourist train service that operates over part of the West Highland Railway Line in Scotland. The Jacobite runs a distance of 41 miles between Fort William and Mallaig, passing through a beautiful area. The route is also the same shown in the Harry Potter films.

### Old Inverlochy Castle

Ruins of a 13th-century castle that was built in the 1200s by the Comyns of Badenoch. There's a legend it was sited on the remains of a fort dating back at least a further five hundred years.

### Ben Nevis Distillery

Ben Nevis Distillery is one of the oldest licensed distilleries in Scotland. The distillery is nestled at the foot of Britain's highest mountain, Ben Nevis.
